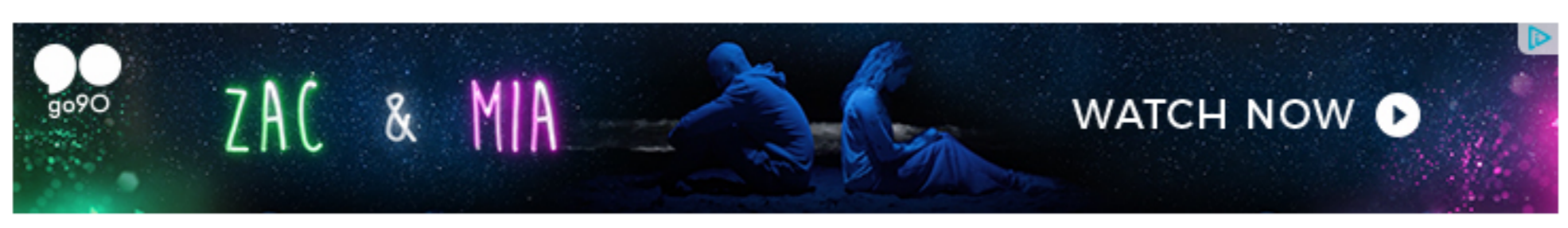

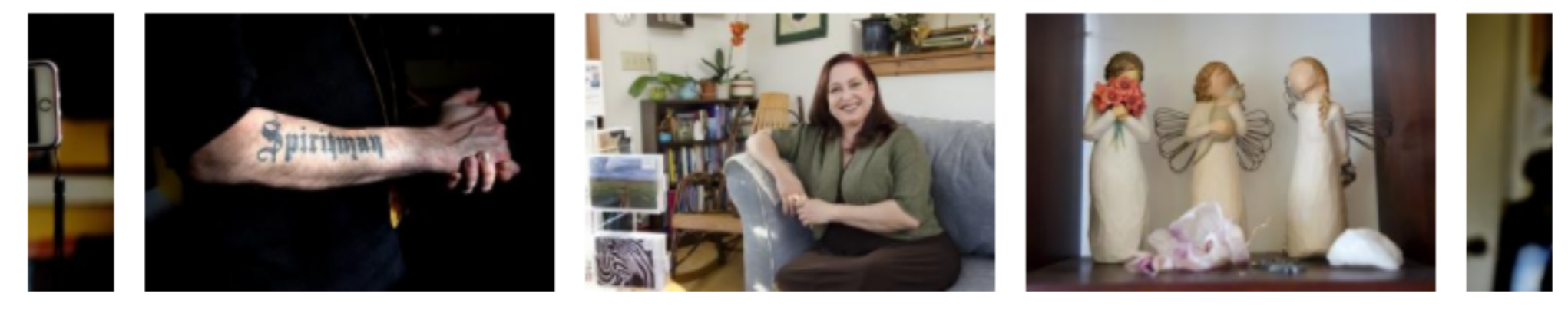

With the New Year approaching, this news organization asked area psychics for the breaking news before it happens. Their prophesied headlines were pretty bleak.

Surrounded by statues of angels and saints, Joseph Tittel sat meditating on his New Year's visions — annual prophecies which have attracted the attention of thousands of followers worldwide.

In an August 2008 radio broadcast, the Bristol Township native predicted the Philadelphia Phillies would win the October 2008 World Series.

During a February 2009 interview on "MTV Live," he prognosticated the death of Michael Jackson, occurring four months later.

In a New Year's Day 2011 podcast, Tittel said he envisioned an East Coast earthquake registering between 5.5 and 6.0 on the Richter scale. Eight months later, an earthquake registering 5.8 put a crack in the Washington Monument.

So, with the New Year approaching, this news organization asked Tittel and other self-described clairvoyants for the breaking news before it happens, and their prophesied headlines were pretty bleak.

In the sunlit studio of her Horsham home office, spiritual medium Karen Hluchan let out a deep sigh. "How far do you want me to go with these?" she asked. "They can be a little upsetting."

A published author, Hluchan leads workshops on communicating with the dead — a disputed and highly controversial practice, which, nonetheless, appears in the Hebrew Bible. In the First Book of Samuel, King Saul searches for a woman who can "divine a ghost." That woman, identified as the Witch of Endor, summons the deceased prophet Samuel who talks to King Saul.

Calling on her own spiritual dream team, Hluchan said she was filled with images and impressions of violence and political turmoil in 2018.

"(President Donald) Trump will still be in office by the end of 2018," said Hluchan. "I also get the thought that, in 2019, the first half of 2019, he will resign."

"I keep getting an impression of a terrorist attack on U.S. soil," Hluchan continued. "Three hundred is the number that I get for the number who are deceased, and, possibly, even 294."

"I'm seeing more protests in the U.S. with the white supremacists and the neo-Nazis," she said. "We will also lose a prominent Republican, who is fighting against Trump. I know who this person is, but I do not want to name him (here) because I do not believe it would be ethical to print that before it happens."

New Jersey pet psychic and medium Teresa St. Frances relies on a different sort of "heavenly tag team" of animals, including a pig named Lola and horse named Shadow. Non-humans are better at this sort of thing, she says.

"Animals are very good at sensing a change in the environment and a change in your health," said the pet psychic. "I can set the clock to when a thunderstorm is coming because my two dogs change their whole attitude."

The year 2018, she said, will be chaotic as "the divine feminine is awakening and stepping into her role. With that epiphany, will come disturbance. You're going to see a tremendous amount of terrorism — men rebelling, feeling uncomfortable. They don't want women in power. They don't want women to speak."

Asked about Trump, the Bergen County clairvoyant said she has consulted the "angels who tell me that he (Trump) has to be here. He's part of the shifting of the consciousness. He brings in with him instability — instability in Congress, the Senate. It's shaking everything up."

While not a supporter of the president, Tittel also said he believed Trump's 2016 victory was in some way "divinely orchestrated."

"He's part of the prophecy of the book of Revelation," Tittel said. "He's in there as the trumpets — the trumpet blowing. Trump ran with Pence. Put those names together and what do you get? It sounds like 'trumpets' and (Trump) has no fear whatsoever in what he says."

Believe him or not, Tittel first gained national attention after appearing in the 2007 Lifetime Television Series "America's Psychic Challenge." In one episode, producers said they transported Tittel to a murder scene where correctly deduced the spot where the victim died, the method of stabbing and other details.

Lately, Tittel said he's been haunted by other, disturbing images of criminal activity which he believes will be exposed in 2018. "It's like a horror movie," he said.

Tittel also said he's getting visions of objects falling from the sky.

"One of the things that came to me was an image of satellites falling from the sky. It's going to be more than one thing," he said. "The year 2018 will be the year that things fall from the sky."

Sometimes, he said, even the clairvoyants hope to be wrong.
